Norbert Elias Foundation Travel Awards Scheme
XIX International Symposium on Civilising Processes

The Norbert Elias Foundation is excited to announce a Travel Awards Scheme for the 19th International Symposium on Civilising Processes (XIX SIPC) to be held from 27–30 November 2022 in Salvador-Bahia, Brazil.

The Award Scheme comprises either:

- Eight (8) intercontinental Travel Awards, OR
- Six (6) intercontinental and four (4) South American (i.e. between South American countries and or/within Brazil) Travel Awards

The Awards cover travel expenses (principally air travel) of researchers from various parts of the world to Bahia, Brazil, for the sole purpose of participating in the XIX SIPC. Accommodation costs (hotel and food) are to be covered by the award holders themselves or their home institutions.

Eligibility is extended to **early career researchers**, this includes: PhD candidates, postdoctoral fellows, university teaching assistants, as well as other early career scholars, including those without institutional support.

Applicants must register for the conference by **15th July 2022**. Participants who are interested in applying for a Travel Award must first have their paper abstract accepted by the SIPC organising committee. After abstract acceptance by the SIPC committee, candidates should complete the Travel Awards application form which must be emailed to the Norbert Elias Foundation secretary@norbert-elias.com by **1st August 2022**. Applications will be reviewed by members of the Board of the Norbert Elias Foundation. Successful candidates will be notified by **4th September 2022**. The Foundation's decision concerning the candidates selected for the Awards will be final, and therefore cannot be appealed.

The resources used for funding the Award Scheme will be exclusively those of the Norbert Elias Foundation. The Foundation, located in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, is a non-profit organisation, independent of public institutions and private companies in any country.
